Sample Lessons with Day-by-Day Scheduling



It is the final hurrah! Your child is almost finished with high school and will have many stories to tell about all the challenging courses. The twelfth grade **language** program consists of a final and complete review of grammar usage with further instruction and requirement in composition. The **vocabulary** focus is on learning new words from context. Unabridged classical literature analyses and book report instruction are included. Study guides are provided.

In **Bible**, students do an in-depth study of the law of God as it applies in today's society and as His directive for Christian leadership in the world. (*Alternates available including extensive doctrinal, catechetical or historical studies.*) The **history** worktext teaches the principles of civil government according to the Holy Scriptures.

Science follows Apologia's track, with three options available — Advanced Chemistry, Human Anatomy or Advanced Physics.

In **math**, *Saxon Calculus* treats all of the topics normally covered in an Advanced Placement AB-level calculus program, as well as many of the topics required for a BC-level program. (Math courses may be selected according to the student's need and ability.)
