Matthew 17.1-8</p> <p>A text to learn Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world. John 17.24</p> <p>A Bible song to sing For God the Lord's a sun and shield: He'll grace and glory give; And will withhold no good from them That uprightly do live. Psalm 84.11</p> <p>A catechism question Q.37 What benefits do believers receive from Christ at death? A. The souls of believers are at their death made perfect in holiness, and do immediately pass into glory, and their bodies, being still united to Christ, do rest in their graves till the resurrection.</p>		
<h2>God is Glorious</h2>		
G	<p>Have you seen the sun setting? Nothing else is so splendid. That is the glory which belongs just to the sun. Sometimes though, the sun's glory is hidden by the clouds. The glory is still there, but we cannot see it.</p> <p>God has a far greater glory than the sun. But people do not see it: it is hidden from them because of their sin. How can we see God's glory? By repenting and learning what God is like. Jesus shows us that. When we learn what Jesus is like, we see God's glory. We can see this a little bit now, but in heaven Christians will see Christ face to face. They will be in glory.</p> <p>The moon has no light of its own. It shines back the sun's light. Christians have no glory of their own. They should reflect the glory of Christ.</p>	G
